# **Statute of The Board for Sports Activities of the University of Presov**

## **Art. 1**

### **Introductory provisions**

1. Board for Sports Activities, (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") is a permanent professional and advisory body of the rector of the University of Presov (hereinafter referred to as "the university") established in accordance with Article 13 Section 4 of the Statute of the University of Presov. The Board supports and coordinates the development of all forms of physical and sporting activity of students of the university, the aim of which is to demonstrate increased physical fitness, mental well-being and health through organised activities, or to achieve sporting performance in competitions at all levels. The Board has no legal personality.
2. A special type of support for sports activities is the support of university sports clubs (hereinafter referred to as "sports clubs") and physical education units (hereinafter referred to as "PE units"). The university creates appropriate conditions for the regeneration, recreation and sporting activities of the university's employees.
3. For operational purposes, the abbreviation RŠČ PU (BSA UP) is used.

## **Art. 2**

### **Mission and activity of the Board**

1. The rector of the university is the founder of the Board and manages its activities through the vice-rector for science, arts, sport and accreditation.
2. The mission of the Board is to promote and coordinate sports activities at the university. The Board coordinates the organisation of sports events of the university and creates conditions for the development of sports activities of sports clubs operating within the university.
3. Resolutions of the Board have the character of recommendations for the academic self-government bodies of the public university, permanent advisory bodies of the rector and other parts of the university.
4. The Board submits a report on its activities annually to its founder.

## **Art. 3**

### **Composition of the Board**

1. The Board consists of representatives of individual sports clubs, PE units and other members appointed by the rector of the university on the proposal of the vice-rector for science, arts, sport and accreditation.
2. The vice-rector for science, arts, sport and accreditation is the chairperson of the Board.

3. The rector, on the proposal of the chairperson of the Board, appoints:
  - a) the vice-chairperson for elite sport and sports representation of the university,
  - b) the vice-chairperson for teaching and coordination of sports activities of the university, who is usually the dean of the Faculty of Sports of the university.
4. The term of office of the members of the Board is identical to that of the rector and ends on the termination of the rector's office.
5. Organisational-technical and administrative support of the Board's activities is provided by the Department for Accreditation, Editorial Activity and Sport.

#### **Art. 4** **Sports clubs**

1. The following criteria must be met in order for a sports club operating at the university to be admitted or included in the Board:
  - a) The membership base of a sports club must consist of a reasonable number of university students, university teachers and university staff. The number of members, taking into account the focus of the sports club, will be determined and approved by the Board.
  - b) A sports club active at the university must have a professional coach with an appropriate valid license and at least one year of continuous coaching experience.
  - c) A sports club may become independent and incorporated as a separate sports club of the Board only if it has existed for at least three years as part of another university sports club and has been in continuous sporting activity.
  - d) A sports club must demonstrate activities and organise events for the sporting enjoyment of the university's students and staff.
  - e) Representation of the university in academic competitions and competitions of sports associations in national or international forums. Alternatively, meeting the sport focus criteria for all students and staff of the university.
2. Members of sports clubs and units can be:
  - a) university students,
  - b) students from other schools,
  - c) university teachers and other university staff,
  - d) external co-workers,
  - e) other natural persons who respect the requirements and principles of individual sports clubs and units.
3. Sports clubs and PE units aim to bring together volunteers interested in sports activities in top-level, performance sports and in sport for all with regard to its health, compensatory, socialization and social impacts.
4. The decision on sports activities is in the immediate competence of the management of each sports club and PE unit according to the internal regulations of the sports club or PE unit.

5. Sports clubs and PE units use the results of their sports activities for the public presentation of the university and the Faculty of Sports at various events and competitions.
6. For their activities, sports clubs and units may use the premises of the university. The university provides them with facilities for the training process and other sports activities in full respect of the applicable internal regulations of the university.

**Art. 5**  
**Board meetings**

1. The Board meets as necessary, but at least twice a year.
2. Meetings of the Board are to be convened by the chairperson of the Board and are to be conducted by him/her in accordance with a predetermined agenda.
3. The Board may meet by attendance, distance, combined or by correspondence form.
4. Minutes is taken of the meetings of the Board. The Department for Accreditation, Editorial Activity and Sports is responsible for its processing and distribution to the members of the Board.

**Art. 6**  
**Final provisions**

1. The Statute of the Sports Activity Council of 28<sup>th</sup> January 2016 is repealed.
2. This Statute enters into force and effect on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2022.
