The part-time mode of doctoral studies is chargeable.

The tuition fee for the part-time mode in the academic year 2025/2026 is 800,- € per academic year. Tuition fees for study programmes exclusively in English language: 3000,- € per academic year.

Full-time mode of study of the standard length of doctoral studies in the Slovak language is free of charge. The tuition fee in full-time mode of doctoral study programmes for exceeding the standard length of study and for concurrent study is EUR 1 800 per academic year.

The basic condition for admission

The basic condition for admission to doctoral studies is the completion of a second-degree study programme. The applicant applies on the form Application for Doctoral Studies of the ŠEVT with the required attachments, which he/she sends to the Department for Education and Doctoral Studies of the Faculty of Arts PU in Prešov. The statement of results of the master's studies is attached in the form of an addendum to the diploma (in this case it is not necessary to fill in the table Statement of results of the master's studies on page 2 of the application form).

Form of admission

The entrance examination is oral and includes a debate on a research issue related to the topic of the projected dissertation in English.

Applicants will take the entrance examination in English.

Graduates of the university in the academic year 2024/2025, who will not have a diploma issued by the application deadline date, will attach to the application a certificate of passing the state examination and defending the diploma thesis, issued by the study department of the relevant faculty after passing the state examination, and will bring to the admission interview or deliver the diploma, the certificate of the state examination and the supplement to the diploma (officially certified) no later than July 1, 2025.

The Faculty will not accept applications received after the closing date or without the required elements.

Annexes to the application form for doctoral studies

1. CV - signed by the applicant;
2. proof of payment of the admission fee - paste on the 3rd page of the application form;
3. officially certified photocopies of evidence of completion of studies (university diploma, state examination certificate, supplement to the diploma (statement of results of master's studies), or certificate of passing the state examination and thesis defence); unofficially certified and unattested copies of evidence of completion of studies from foreign universities will not be accepted;
4. a list of professional and scientific works published to date;
5. a framework project of the dissertation on the topic written by the supervisor in English, including a compulsory annotation in English (5-10 lines). The recommended length of the dissertation project is 9 000 characters including spaces (5 standard pages). The dissertation project should be submitted together with the PhD application form in hard copy and also sent electronically by email to martina.muchova@unipo.sk by the deadline for submission of applications. Applicants are advised to contact the supervisor who writes the selected dissertation topic before selecting a dissertation topic.
