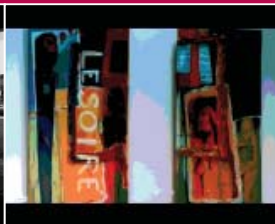
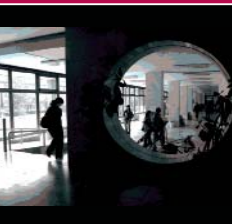

## 1. WHY STUDY

### AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PREŠOV...

**PREŠOV HAS** a long-established tradition of education and academic excellence.

**THE UNIVERSITY** of Prešov has been a stabile constituent of the Slovak higher education space for a longer period of time. Some of its faculties have been here for more than a half of a century, other for several decades and in case of the younger ones – just several years. A wide time horizon of its presence at the Slovak intellectual scene has been a proof of a deep necessity to take care of education and the intellectual cultivation of young people generations who present not only the strength of traditions and beliefs of our ancestors but also a hope facing the future.

**FROM ITS** very beginnings, the University of Prešov has provided the highest standards of academic education to both Slovak and foreign students across a wide range of studies in the fields of humanities, natural, theological, and managerial sciences, health and sports. At present, the University of Prešov consists of eight faculties:

## THE FACULTY OF ARTS

**IS IT** really necessary to introduce the Faculty of Arts – the biggest component of the University of Prešov?

**SINCE ITS** foundation it has functioned as a competitor to the elitist position of Slovak higher education in Bratislava. The specific status of the Faculty of Arts in the Eastern Slovakia region has been preserved till the present and its reputation has spread throughout many universities abroad.

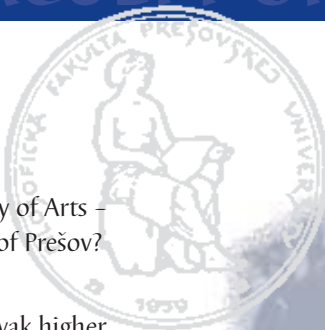
**YOU WILL** study under professional supervision of teachers who are very successful and highly regarded even abroad. Majority of them transfer theoretical knowledge into practice and work as translators, interpreters and experts.

## STUDY

**THE FIRST** graduates of the Faculty of Arts were only secondary school teachers and successive new study branches (including non-teacher specializations) have been created.

**CONTEMPORARY APPLICANTS** can benefit from a wide range of attractive teacher training and non-teacher training study programs, fully accredited in all three levels of study – translation and interpreting in German, French, Spanish, Russian and Ukrainian languages, British and American studies, Slovak studies, general linguistics, mass-media studies and Russian studies, Ukrainian studies, Slavic studies, philosophy and ethics, educational and social work, aesthetics, theory of arts and culture, history, political sciences and psychology. A variety

of study programs concentrated at one faculty offers students, during their study period, contact with colleagues from other academic specializations, not only in everyday life but especially at professional level (participation in Students' academic and professional activities and participation in regularly organized students' academic conferences), at social and cultural level (such performances as Academic Prešov, DM Discs or matriculation balls). Permanent interaction among students exists due to the university's radio studio in the hall of residence.



# THE FACULTY OF ARTS

**SOME DEPARTMENTS** created highly specialized workplaces:

**As a** prospective psychologist you can use a computer laboratory to analyze research data, database of psycho-diagnostic techniques and tools. You can go through professional practical training in consulting and psycho-therapeutic equipments.

**PROSPECTIVE TRANSLATORS** and interpreters have possibilities to obtain practical experience in a specialized laboratory for simultaneous interpreting that fully meets the European Union standards. Would you like to work in this area and translate for the European institutions? Do not hesitate and use the offers of the Interpreting Institution that is organizing courses and specialized seminars focused on professional translation and interpreting even for public.

## INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

**YOU WILL** have the chance to meet and discuss various social issues with foreign and Slovak guests invited from universities and social spheres. Existing international bilateral agreements and contracts

between the Faculty of Arts and other foreign universities offer wide choices to study abroad (LLP – Erasmus program and other possibilities).

## FACILITIES

**IN THE** Faculty of Arts building there is a university library as well as departmental libraries and wireless internet connection. The faculty is situated in a pleasant area, comprising a hall of residence, student canteen, medical care facilities, student service and information center, shopping center and other sport facilities (dormitory stadium, gymnasium, indoor swimming pool, town sport hall and winter stadium).


experience a pleasant atmosphere at the faculty and you can spiritually recuperate in our chapel.

## THE FACULTY OF HUMANITIES AND NATURAL SCIENCES

**WOULD YOU** like to choose among attractive study program that help you to develop the skills necessary in the contemporary job market? The Faculty of Humanities and Natural Sciences is here to offer it to you. Whether you are interested in humanities, natural sciences or artistic study branches, you will find a suitable study program. The faculty has a long tradition and experience not only with preparing young people for their future job (teacher and non-teacher) but it is well respected in the Slovak higher education scene. This was proved in 2006 when the faculty won the 1<sup>st</sup> prize among Slovak faculties, and in 2007 when the faculty was awarded the Juraj Fandly medal for quality of education.

### WHY STUDY AT THIS FACULTY?

**BECAUSE THE** Faculty of Humanities and Natural Sciences has several top ranking laboratories.

**AT THE** Department of Biology there is a unique laboratory of molecular genetics and a unique genetic analyzer of its type – MegaBASE 7560 (used for medical and forensic purposes);

**AT THE** Department of Geography and Regional Development there are two top quality laboratories – a geological laboratory and a laboratory of geographic information systems (GIS). You will be trained here to create digitalized maps by means of GIS and you will have opportunities to use all top measuring devices during your field practical lessons

such as GPS (System of satellite navigation – Leica Geosystem GS 20), barometer, altimeter, theodolite and others.

**AT THE** Department of Physics you can use computer rooms equipped with the Philip Harris system.

**THE DEPARTMENT** of Technology and Digital Competence has laboratories, workshops and specialized classrooms of high quality.

**THE DEPARTMENT** of English Language and Literature is very well equipped with a departmental self-education and resource center (library with computers and 9000 publications).

**AT THE** Department of Fine Arts you will have opportunities to develop your artistic creativity in well equipped and specialized studios.

# THE FACULTY OF HUMANITIES AND NATURAL SCIENCES

**YOU WILL** work under the guidance of highly qualified teachers (professors, senior lecturers and Ph.D.s) who are very active in their research work, and work on national and international academic, scientific and research projects (in which you can also participate). Some are important personalities of the regional as well as Slovak artistic scene and they are members of well-known and respected international organizations.



## ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES

**WOULD YOU** like to improve your qualifications? You have the chance to achieve this at the Department of English language and literature – this department, as the only one in Slovakia, has the right to award the internationally accepted certificate for English teachers under the auspices of City & Guilds. Under such auspices, the department can administer English language examinations and award the internationally accepted certificate of language competence to successful students.

**APART FROM** teacher training specializations you can also choose from a wide range of attractive and popular non-teacher study programs such as *Library and Slovak Studies* which, as the only one in the region (and one of three in Slovakia), offers the opportunity to take specialist courses such as *Library and Information Studies* as well as *English Language and Culture*, *Biology and Geography in Regional Development*.

**THANKS TO** the Computer Technology Center at the Faculty of Humanities and Natural Sciences, SANET – the network of the Slovak Academic Database has been successfully developed and it is safe and regularly modernized.

**ARE YOU** fully satisfied with a Masters, Mgr. (M.A.), degree? If not, you can continue your studies in Anthropology, Environmental Ecology, Pedagogy and Regional Geography to attain the academic title of Ph.D.

## INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

**THE FACULTY**, within the framework of various programs, has been cooperating with foreign faculties (Erasmus), inviting teachers and students, and offering mobility stays to students and trainee teachers. 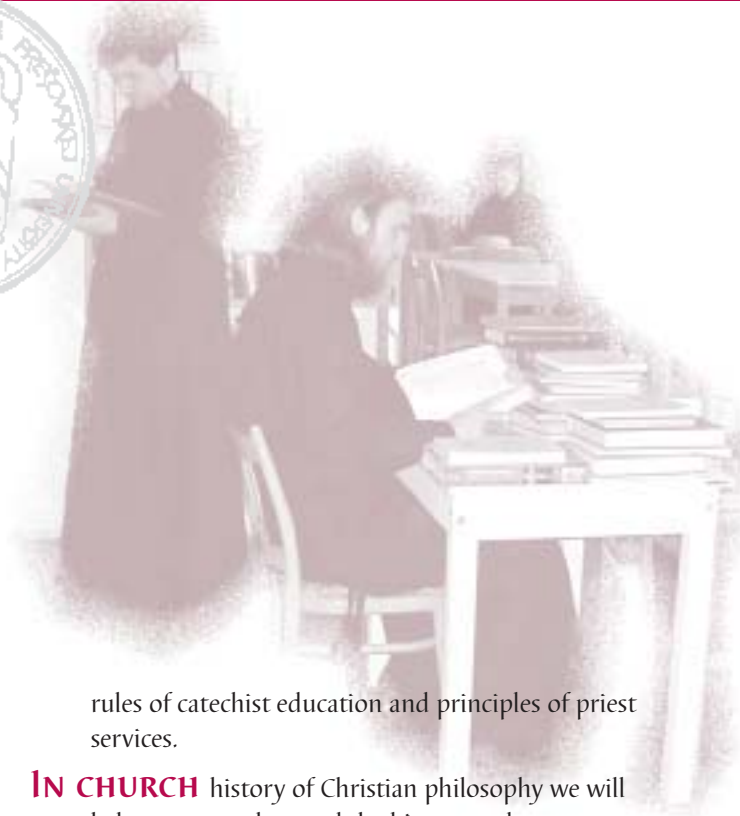
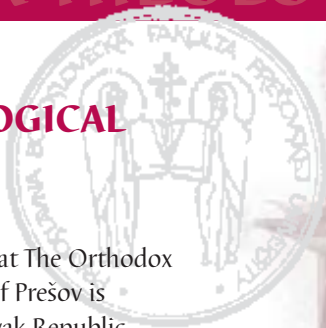

## ORTHODOX THEOLOGICAL FACULTY



**ONE THING** you should know is that The Orthodox Theological Faculty of University of Prešov is the only one of its kind in the Slovak Republic. Education and research have been realized in eight departments: Department of biblical sciences, Department of systematic theology, Department of practical theology, Department of church history and Christian philosophy, Department of Byzantine studies, Department of Christian anthropology and social work, Department of Christian pedagogy and psychology and the Department of Greek language and culture. It is clear from the names of the departments that we offer the possibility to get topical information, skills and knowledge.

**IN BIBLICAL** studies we will help you to know God's word written in the Bible and to understand it properly, we offer you a wealth of orthodox tradition in explanations of the Bible from the first centuries till the present day.

**IN ORTHODOX** systematic theology we will help you to understand orthodox theology, we offer you the chance to better understand theological perspectives and views from the period of holy Apostles and holy fathers to the present theologians and you can create your own view on orthodoxy.

**IN PRACTICAL** theology we will help you to understand the practical part of the liturgical life of the church – religious services, sacraments, prayer life, religious songs, preacher art, and pedagogical

rules of catechist education and principles of priest services.

**IN CHURCH** history of Christian philosophy we will help you to understand the history and structure of the Church from its creation till the present. We will focus on the history of the Orthodox Church in Czech lands, Moravia and Slovakia and we will give you explanations on Christian philosophy.

**IN BYZANTINE** studies we will teach you the theological, liturgical and spiritual riches of Byzantium, which arrived here thanks to the mission of two apostles – Cyril and Method. This is a central part of European and world culture. Orthodox theology and spiritual life is a continuation of the principles of the Byzantine tradition which is so topical at present.

# ORTHODOX THEOLOGICAL FACULTY

**In CHRISTIAN** Science about man and social work – we will assist you to better understand social services for a man as a creature of God using Christian knowledge, sociology, psychology and pedagogy according to contemporary conditions and needs of society.

**In CHRISTIAN** pedagogy and psychology we will help you to get knowledge from pedagogy and psychology based on Christian philosophy and conception of man as God's image.

**In GREEK** language and culture we will help you to get to know Greek language and culture, Greek history, philosophy and theology from antiquity till the present. You can continue your studies at the well-known Greek universities of Thessalonika and Athens.

**Would YOU** like to understand the abovementioned study areas? Would you like to know what sort of explanations traditional orthodox Christianity offers? Would you like to know your history connected with the mission of the holy brothers Cyril and Method? Would you like to understand properly what you are interested in? **THE FACULTY** cooperates with many foreign universities, within the framework of LLP, the Erasmus program has signed many bilateral agreements allowing its students to study abroad.

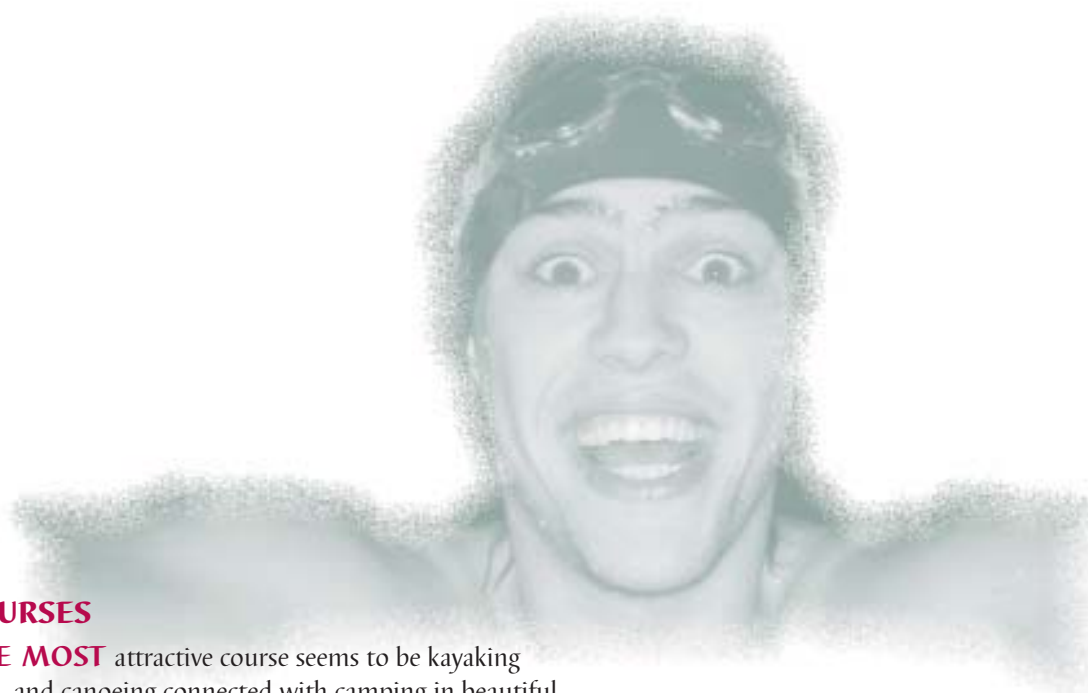

## THE FACULTY OF HEALTH CARE

**WHEN YOU** decide to study at the Faculty of Health Care, you have to realize that the occupation of a medical worker requires mainly love, a fair amount of responsibility for human life, professional skills, empathetic and assertive conduct with individuals, groups of people and communities.

## STUDY

**AT THE** Faculty of Health Care at the first, B. A., level you can study in the following study programs: nursing, physiotherapy, dental hygiene, midwifery, urgent health care as a full-time or part-time student and become a nurse, physiotherapist, midwife, dental hygienist or rescuer.

**THE SECOND** level of university study offers nursing and physiotherapy. All the abovementioned programs are very interesting and specific and they have one thing in common – they are caring professions.

## MODERN TENDENCIES

**THE NEWLY** reconstructed building of the faculty has well-equipped lecture theatres and specialized classrooms, multi-media library with a lot of Slovak and foreign professional publications, magazines resources and databases.

**THE TEACHING** consists of theoretical and practical parts. You can test the acquired knowledge and

skills during work experience in the faculty hospital and clinical training at clinics, which are also educational workplaces. Here you get the chance to get in touch with reality. Here you meet people who need professional and human help and assistance. It is amazing to live with the feeling that you helped somebody. Our practical training courses and exercises held in real conditions and realized by students of urgent health care and members of integrated rescue system are also very attractive and educational.

# THE FACULTY OF HEALTH CARE

## PROJECTS

**APART FROM** studies there are a lot of other activities you can enjoy. Under teachers supervision students realize a project called *Evička a deti* (*Little Eve and Children*) focused on disease prevention and first aid to common injuries of pre-school children. Another attractive project with students' participation called *Adamko hravo-zdravo* (*Happy Healthy Adam*) is a multi-media project to promote health and is aimed at children in kindergartens and primary schools. In cooperation with secondary schools, our students participate in a project focused on cancer prevention.

**WE ALSO** try to spread information concerning prevention of drug addiction at primary and secondary schools.

**STUDENTS PARTICIPATE** in various activities organized by the town council, Slovak Red Cross, Office of Public Health and Slovak League Against Cancer.

## INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

**IN THE** framework of LLP – Erasmus program, the faculty creates good conditions for international exchange stays, mobilities and placements in such countries as the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Germany, Austria and Holland. To study abroad is an experience that cannot be substituted by any other activity.

## 2. UNIPO CENTER

### UNIVERSITY INFORMATION CENTER (UIC)

**TO PARTICIPATE** in optimizing university study and professional adaptation of students and to improve study conditions. Its activities have been modified according to the actual needs of students and according to consultants. Professional counseling is guaranteed by full-time experts and activities in cooperation with professional institutions in Slovakia and abroad.

**TO DEVELOP** marketing activities and advertise conditions and the possibility of study stays at the University of Prešov.

**THE STUDENT** Service and Information Center provides a wide range of services for students in the following areas:

- Information technology (IT) services
- Promotional services

### INFORMATION SERVICES:

- The UIC provides information about job opportunities for graduating students from all faculties at the university.
- The UIC provides information about supply-teaching opportunities to students who are studying to become teachers in our region and who may eventually substitute for people in other branches.

- Other services – reference only loan, loan for home use, copying services,
- Advisory services
- 44 computers are connected to the Internet
- To provide library and information services (including on-line book catalogue), the University Library has been using the automated ALEPH library system

### BIBLIOGRAPHIC – INFORMATION SERVICES:

- The University Library provides or requests bibliographic searches from internal information resources (Slovak National Bibliography, Czech National Bibliography) free of charge, from external home and foreign database centers (EIFL Direct, Knovel, Science Direct, ProQuest 500, Web of Knowledge, etc.) under conditions set by the supplier (usually free of charge).

### ADVISORY AND CONSULTATION SERVICES:

- Lectures focused on using primary and secondary library apparatus,
- Bibliographic consultations on writing seminar papers and projects, final dissertations and theses,
- Methodological assistance in using searches, catalogues and services.

### REPROGRAPHIC SERVICES:

- Services are offered only from information resources of the University Library for 24 hours in accordance with the price list and service list as well as the conditions included in the Author's Act.

### OTHER SERVICES:

- Since 1998, the University Library has processed and registered publication activities of university staff by computers.
- Since 2002, the University Library has presented full-text electronic documents (academic textbooks, monographs, anthologies, catalogues of fine arts, etc.) on its website.
- Since 2002, the University Library has digitalized music compositions using its own financial resources and offers them to readers in a multi-mass media and database study room.

**IS THE** University's oldest performing choir, was created in 1964. It is a category A choir, interpreting compositions from various style periods and presenting pieces of Slovak composers.

## **NOSTRO CANTO – MIXED-VOICE CHOIR**

**THE REPERTOIRE** is filled with a range of outstanding genre varieties including compositions of renaissance, baroque and romanticism, contemporary composers, folk songs from all over the world, spirituals, jazz and musical standards.

## **ST. ROMAN SLADKOPEVEC CHORUS**

**THIS MALE-VOICE** choir performs sacral compositions of the Byzantine rite. It is an integral continuation of theological preparation of future priests and a part of the life of the Greek Catholic Church in Slovakia.

## **STUDENT CHOIR OF THE ORTHODOX THEOLOGICAL FACULTY**

**WAS ESTABLISHED** in 1992. Multi-vocal singing represents various interpretational periods and different styles – compositions of Russian, Ukrainian and Greek composers.

## **PIANO VOCAL**

**WAS CREATED** in 1999 and was shaped into a representative artistic choir that is focused on solo and chamber singing of various style periods



and genres from renaissance, through baroque and classicism up to the present.

## **STUDENT THEATRE**

**STARTED ITS** history in 1960. Today it is part of the Department of Cultural Studies, Institute of Aesthetics, Arts and Cultural Studies of the Faculty of Arts. It is an amateur theatre troupe with approximately 15 student actors. The ensemble concentrates mainly on literature and the possibilities of its stage interpretation.

## **MEDIÁLKA TV**

**IS AN** internet television of the University of Prešov. Its main intention is to inform the academic staff about up-to-date and current issues and news at the university.

## **RADIO PAF**

**IS AN** internet radio studio of the University of Prešov. It opens space for creative students work in the area of radio production.

## STUDENTS HALLS OF RESIDENCE AND THE CANTEEN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PREŠOV

**THE HALLS** are situated at several sites. The total accommodation capacity of all four halls together is 1,994 students.

**FOR FOREIGN** students accommodation is available in double-rooms, all of them having complete bathroom facilities, in the form of en-suite units. Internet connection is available in some rooms. No. 11, 17<sup>th</sup> November Street provides various services for students: medical center (doctor's and dentist's surgeries), beautician, hairdresser, photocopying etc.

**THE COST** of a student room for incoming students is 60 EURO for a complete month and is paid in advance. When you want to move out you must give at least one month's notice in advance in a written form.

**INTERNATIONAL OFFICE** offers and coordinates services for incoming and outgoing exchange students, international exchange and degree students.

**EXCHANGE STUDENTS** are non-degree students who intend to study at the University of Prešov for one or two semesters and participate in bilateral or international student exchange programmes.

**NON-DEGREE STUDENTS** who do not participate in a student exchange programme are considered as visiting students.

**TEACHING AT** the University of Prešov is mainly done in Slovak. For international students, however, the university offers 2 BACHELOR STUDY PROGRAMMES and 5 MODULES taught in English.

### BACHELOR STUDY PROGRAMMES (THREE YEARS)

## **STUDY PROGRAMME : MIDWIFERY DEGREE : BACHELOR LENGTH OF STUDY : 3 YEARS NUMBER OF CREDITS : 180**

### **GRADUATE PROFILE**

A midwifery is able to provide independent individual care to women and children— i.e. preventive, supportive, therapeutic treatment, and helping care.

This care is provided for women especially during the period of their pregnancy, during the delivery phase, and in the period following delivery; for the families of these women, as well as for specific groups and communities of women.

A midwifery uses the methods of nursery work. She maintains and supports the optimal health conditions for women and their children, as well as their families, and for the specific groups and communities of women in various situations who need the aid of a midwifery.

### **GRADUATES EMPLOYMENT PROSPECT**

Graduates from the Midwifery field of study will have achieved a university education in the field of midwifery with a focus on providing health care. They can work as delivery assistants in nursery practice at gynaecological-delivery departments; in the field of community care of women; in leadership and research, and in the field of education.

A midwifery can work privately and independently, within the framework of established regulations. Through further educational studies, midwifery can gain more specialized skills.

### **STUDY PROGRAMME MODULES**

**1. Theoretical foundations of midwifery:** nursery process in its full range; taking care of sexual and reproductive health of a woman; planned parenthood; conceptual models in midwifery; the history of nursery and midwifery; theories and models suitable for midwifery; specific issues of nursery process in midwifery.

**2. Midwifery 1, 2:** focuses on nursing a woman during the period of physiological pregnancy, the phase of delivery and in the period of puerperium; 3 and 4: focuses on nursing a woman during the period of physiological pregnancy, the phase of delivery and in the period of puerperium at pathological conditions.

**3. Biomedical subjects:** human anatomy, physiology and pathology (with special focus on woman), embryology, basics of biophysics, biochemistry, radiology, basics of microbiology, immunology, virology, allergology, epidemiology and hygiene,

midwifery and gynaecology, basics of pharmacology with the special emphasis put on the pharmacology in the field of midwifery, gynaecology and neonatology, basics of paediatrics with the focus on neonatology, clinical genetics, basics of intensive care with the focus on the field of midwifery and neonatology, basics of clinical propedeutics, first aid rules - specially in midwifery, gynaecology, neonatology, and nursing techniques.

**4. Clinical practice** at the gynaecological-midwifery departments: gynaecological department, department of endangered pregnancy, puerperium department, delivery rooms, newborn department, specialized gynaecological departments, antenatal clinic, intensive care units of newborn departments and gynaecological-delivery departments, oncology department, community care.

**5. Humanistic – behavioural subjects:** general and developmental psychology, psychology of a woman and prenatal psychology, general sociology and the sociology of family, ethics, legal studies and legislation, philosophy, health education, communication, psychiatry, psycho-hygiene, information technologies, public health care and health education, educational activity of a nurse in care of woman, child, family.

**6. Bachelor thesis** – the basics of research (basic methods of data collection, work with literature, the application of the research outcomes in the practice), diploma seminar.

In addition, the graduates have achieved an insight into the essentials of marketing, management, economy, law, psychology and the issues of the European integration with regard to intercultural business communication.

The graduates are acquainted with the essential concepts of linguistic science and they have developed intercultural and professional communication skills in English.

In addition, they have an insight into the history and culture of the English speaking countries.

The graduates also have basic knowledge of economy, management, marketing and law.

### GRADUATES EMPLOYMENT PROSPECT

Achieving a better understanding of cultural differences and unbiased world-view, the graduates of the programme will become indispensable experts in international cultural and business relations in local governments and state administration, in small and medium size enterprises as well as in cultural and non-profit organizations and tourist agencies dealing with foreign clients.

### STUDY PROGRAMME MODULES

#### MODULE 1: LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT.

This module focuses on improving the trainees' speaking, writing, listening and reading skills in everyday as well as in professional communication.

#### MODULE 2: HISTORY, GEOGRAPHY, CULTURE, LITERATURE AND ARTS OF ENGLISH SPEAKING COUNTRIES.

This module is based on analysing the historical landmarks of the UK and the USA, highlighting the key problems on the path along which the UK and the USA have advanced since ancient times up to now, on analysing the works of the major representatives of

British and American literature and on evaluating the selected works of art and thus identifying the specific features of British and American culture.

#### MODULE 3: LINGUISTICS.

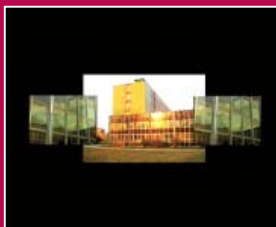
