Testing of basic communicative skills (spoken interaction, spoken production, listening reading, writing), testing of basic vocabulary a basic grammatical rules in Slovak.

Course objective:

To acquire language skills and competences within the basic Slovak at the level A1 according to Common European Framework.

Course content:

- 1. Slovak as a Foreign Language. Slovak as a one of the least widely used languages across Europe: Genetic, Area, Typological Aspects. Communicative Competence in Foreign Language Teaching/Learning. Modelling of Special Speech Act Components in Foreign Language Teaching/Learning.
- 2. Communicative situations: greeting and meeting people, day-to-day communication, everyday living, study, university, traveling etc.
- 3. Spoken interaction:

Basic communication phrases and intentions: greeting and meeting people, contact people, acquire of information, exchange of information etc.

4. Spoken production:

Using simple sentences and phrases to introduce myself. Basic rules of Slovak pronunciation.

5. Listening comprehension:

The understanding of very simple dialogues and very short notices and texts. To recognise of communicative intention and key information in simple text.

6. Reading comprehension:

Reading and understanding of very short, simple sentences, notices and texts. To recognise of communicative intention and key information in simple text.

7. Writing:

Writing of short, simple text. Filling in forms with personal details. Basic rules of Slovak orthography.

8 Vocabulary

Basic Slovak vocabulary and phrases related to the frequent topics and situations. The using of lexical relations as hyperonymy – hyponymy, antonymy and word-formation motivation.

Grammar:

Simple grammatical structures and sentence patterns. Basic structure of the Slovak sentence (S - V - O). Basic forms of the words classes (nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, numerals).

10. Sociolinguistic and sociocultural competence:

Communicative norms in Slovak, politness conventions. Slovak culture, traditions, habits. Host university, host town, host country.
