A doctoral student needs to obtain 75 credits for the study part, which represents 41.6% of the total number of credits required for the proper completion of studies. Compulsory courses, including the dissertation examination, account for 43 credits (23.8% of the total number of 180 credits). The recommended study programme offers the possibility to enrol in obligatory elective courses for 48 credits. In order to graduate properly, a doctoral student needs to obtain a minimum of 24 credits for the obligatory elective courses.

A doctoral student needs to obtain 75 credits for scientific creative activity, which represents 41.6 % of the total number of credits required for regular graduation.

For the defence of the dissertation thesis, which completes the doctoral studies, 30 credits are obtained.
