

I would like to acknowledge that the reverend- father, associate professor ThDr. Stefan Pruzinsky PhD. (born 03.09.1974) is a respected Slovak Orthodox theologian and scholar, specializing in the field of New Testament studies.

His career as a scholar and tertiary lecturer has spanned a long period, covering almost two decades of research and teaching. His academic and educational work was mainly centered at the Orthodox Theological faculty of the Presov University, where he played a strategic role in its development. His work was also associated with the development of basic and advanced academic programs. His career includes textbooks and monographs, especially related to exegesis and New Testament criticism, such as for example, "The General letter of the Holy apostle James, exegesis of the 4th chapter", (Bialystok, Poland, 2022); further, "Sainthood and secularity in the epistle of the apostle Jacob, exegesis of verses 4,1-10", (Elpis, Poland, 2020), "General letter of saint apostle James : exegesis of 3rd chapter, (Bialystok, Poland, 2019)". These substantial monographs have been supplemented by numerous articles in theological areas and Biblical studies. He has participated in numerous scholarly conferences and workshops abroad, including studies in Thessaloniki, Greece.

Associate Professor Stefan Pruzinsky is a long time member of the department of Biblical studies at the Orthodox theological faculty in Presov, and is and was involved in the formation of many students both undergraduate and postgraduate, teaching subjects related to Biblical literature and Biblical criticism. He is a member of multiple professional organizations related to Biblical studies, he is a member of the Slovak Biblical society and other related organizations, being involved in the translation of the Bible into Slovak and the study of the church-Slavonic biblical tradition. As a Biblical scholar he is involved in similar international projects.

We would certainly like to recommend him to further academic advancement including the possibility of gaining higher academic positions and possibilities within the framework of the degree of professor.
