1 Terms of Admission

1.1 The basic prerequisite for admission to study master's degree programmes (the second level of higher education within the meaning of Section 53 of Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education) is the completion of the first-degree study programme in the relevant field of study of the subsequent master's degree programme. In the field of teaching and pedagogical sciences, completion of the subjects of pedagogy and psychology and passing the state examination in these subjects are required.

Applicants from abroad are required to submit a certified copy of their diploma with an addendum.

1.2 An applicant may be accepted to a master's study programme without an entrance examination if the master's study programme is a continuation of a bachelor's study programme in the given field of study and the applicant has passed the state examination in subjects that are equivalent to the subjects of the state examination of the corresponding bachelor's study programme at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Prešov in Prešov.

1.3 The entrance exam will include a written knowledge test or an oral interview and/or a talent test to verify the applicant's aptitude, in the following cases:

- a) if the conditions under paragraph 1.2 are not met;



- b) if the applicant has not completed the bachelor's degree at the Faculty of Arts of the PU in Prešov and the PRSP of the relevant study programme recommends the written test and/or talent test.

1.3.1 A theory-based written test consisting of the given subject areas will be implemented in the following study programmes:

a) Standard study programmes

- **English Language and Anglophone Cultures:** English language, British and American literature and British and American studies;
- **Archival Science:** auxiliary historical sciences and archival science;
- **Ethics:** history of philosophy and ethics a systemic ethics;
- **Aesthetics:** history and theory of aesthetics, history, theory and aesthetics of selected type of art;
- **Philosophy:** history of philosophy and systemic philosophy;
- **History:** general history and Slovak history;
- **Media Studies:** theory and practice media communication and contemporary Slovak language in media; in addition to the theory-based written test, the admission procedure will also include a talent test, consisting of a short written composition and an oral performance;
- **Political Science:** theory of politics and political systems, comparative political science and public administration (history and the present);
- **Psychology:** psychological methodology, general psychology and rudiments of applied psychological disciplines;
- **Russian Studies:** Russian language, Russian literature and Russian history and culture;
- **Slovak Language and Literature:** Slovak language and Slovak literature;
- **Central-Europe Studies:** Polish language (Slovak students) or Slovak language (foreign students – CEFR level B1) and an overview of Central-European literatures, cultures and history.

b) Translation Study Programmes:

- **English Language and Culture Combined:** a reading-comprehension-based test, CEFR level C1;
- **French Language and Culture Combined:** translation from French language, translation to French language, theory and history of literary translation and interpreting theory;
- **German Language and Culture Combined:** German morphology, German syntax, the culture of the countries of the German language area, theory and history of literary translation and interpreting theory;
- **Russian Language and Culture Combined:** Russian language, Russian literature, Russian history and culture, translation theory and history and interpreting theory;
- **Slovak Language and Culture Combined:** A theory-based test from the theory of Slovak language and Slovak literature and culture;
- **Ukrainian Language and Culture Combined:** Ukrainian language, Ukrainian literature, Ukrainian history and culture, theory and history of literary translation and interpreting theory;

c) Teacher-training Study Programmes:

- **Teaching of English Language and Literature Combined:** English language and British and American literature
- **Teaching of History Combined:** general history and Slovak history;
- **Teaching of Aesthetics Combined:** history and theory of aesthetics, history, theory and aesthetics of selected type of art;
- **Teaching of French Language and Literature Combined:** French language and French literature
- **Teaching of Music Combined:** History and theory and practical interpretation of music;



- **Teaching of German Language and Literature Combined:** German language and German literature
- **Teaching of Russian Language and Literature Combined:** Russian language and Russian literature;
- **Teaching of Slovak Language and Literature Combined:** Slovak language and Slovak literature
- **Teaching of Ukrainian Language and Literature Combined:** Ukrainian language and Ukrainian literature
- **Teaching of Civics Combined:** history of philosophy, general economic theory, sociology, rudiments of theory of state and law and constitutional law;
- **Teaching of Art Combined:** History of art and basic art techniques.

1.3.2 The oral entrance exam will be conducted in the study programme:

- **Social Work:** psychology and sociology in social work and theory and methods of social work;

1.3.3 Talent test will be conducted in the study programmes:

- **Teaching of Art Combined** – see also Point I
- **Teaching of Music Combined** – see also Point I

A candidate who has completed a bachelor's study programme pursuant to paragraph 1.2 (a), (b), (c) at another faculty or university shall also have the right to study a master's study programme.

2 Other Provisions

Applicants who have fulfilled the conditions for admission, but for capacity or other reasons cannot be admitted to their chosen study programme, may be admitted by the Dean of the Faculty to another study programme of the Faculty with free capacity.

In the event that the planned number of places in the relevant study programme is not filled, other applicants with the necessary abilities and aptitudes for study will be admitted, at the discretion of the competent authority.

The Faculty reserves the right not to open a full-time study programme for which a low number of applicants applies.

Applicants for study with a disability who have fulfilled the conditions for admission, but due to the limitations resulting from their disability have not realistically evaluated the suitability of the selected study programme in terms of the technical difficulty of study, the limits and functional impact of the disability, for future employment and the exercise of the profession, may be admitted by the Dean of the Faculty (on the basis of the recommendation of the PRSP¹) to another study programme in which there is free capacity.
