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- The applicant who has already taken the school-leaving exam shall submit together with the application for study the certified copies of secondary school certificates for 1. – 3. year of study (four-year secondary school study), secondary school certificates for 1. – 4. year of study (five-year secondary school study) and a certified copy of the school-leaving exam certificate.
- The applicant shall submit a handwritten signed CV.
- An applicant with special needs, under Art. 100 of the Act no.: 131/2002 Coll. on universities and on amendment and supplements of certain laws, provides documentary evidence for special needs in the application by a respective letter of request and a letter of confirmation. The letter of request is published on the faculty's website in the section Applicants – study options.
- **Incomplete applications shall not be accepted and fee for admission proceedings shall not be returned.**

Note: After completion of the first degree of studies (Bc.) there is a possibility to continue at the second degree of studies (Mgr.) in all study programmes.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

A requirement for admission is a submission of a certificate of completion of secondary school education with a school-leaving exam (matura exam). The school leaving certificates must be officially certified and within the deadline and fixed date thereof submitted to the Admissions Office of Faculty of Education, University of Prešov. The above-mentioned requirement for admission applies also to international students. Applicants are advised to successfully complete a foundation course in Slovak language. Self-payers are admitted on the basis of a contract. Directive on tuition fee and fees for the respective academic year is published on <http://www.unipo.sk/pedagogicka-fakulta>.

ADMISSION PROCEEDINGS

In the case of a significantly larger number of applicants, the faculty may decide to conduct an admissions interview with applicants, in which their level of motivation for studying in the Teacher Training study programme will be determined.

A criterion used for determining the order of applicants eligible for admission to all undergraduate programmes in full-time and part-time form shall be study results from secondary school, an average of grades stated in the end-of-year certificates for 1. – 3. year (four-year secondary school study), for 1. – 4. year (five-year secondary school study):

The final order of applicants is determined according to the overall number of points which an applicant is awarded on the basis of the results achieved during secondary school education (average of grades stated in end-of-year certificates) and for a possible admission interview.

If the number of applicants shall be greater than administrative capacities of the faculty, the applicants with higher average study score will be admitted. The admission proceedings results shall be published in the information system MAIS
