Annotation

The project brings an innovative approach to education in primary and secondary schools in the Czech-Slovak border region, where it emphasizes experiential pedagogy and activities in nature.

The aim of the project is to create a methodology and implement adaptation and sports courses for primary and secondary schools in the Czech-Slovak border region, thereby supporting the mental wellbeing, health and active lifestyle of children. The main components of the project include the development of methodological materials for the preparation and implementation of courses using modern technologies, training of teaching staff and the implementation of adaptation and sports courses for pupils and students of the participating schools. Special attention is paid to the integration of children with specific needs, the use of modern technologies in accordance with outdoor activities and the integration of traditional and modern educational methods.

The project supports cross-border cooperation and knowledge exchange between the Czechia and Slovakia, which contributes to strengthening social cohesion, the transfer of good practice and cultural understanding.
