# Conditions for passing the course:

Course assessment and completion: continuous evaluation (classified)

#### Continuous evaluation:

- a) systematic work in the lesson according to the teacher's instructions
- b) elaboration, presentation and submission of a semester project on a given issue according to the instructions of the teacher 15 points (30% of the course evaluation)
- c) passing a written test at the end of the semester 35 points (70% of the course evaluation)

# Final evaluation:

The success criteria for the classification levels are as follows: A: 100.00 - 90.00%; B: 89.99 - 80.00%; C: 79.99 - 70.00%; D: 69.99 - 60.00%; E: 59.99 - 50.00%; FX: 49.99 and less% at least 50%. A student who obtains less than 50% will be graded FX.

The student must develop, present and submit a semester project in order to participate in a written test and thus obtain an overall assessment and credits based on the criteria of success.

Completion of the course is conditioned by successful completion of the set conditions and fulfillment of the conditions of participation according to the Study Rules of the University of Presov.

- identify the features of individual styles in selected important monuments in Slovakia,
- to express and discuss in the field of culture and the arts,
- assign important art representatives to the style and identify their most famous works,
- clarify the use of monuments for tourism destinations,
- understands the need to protect monuments for future generations and for tourism,
- formulate and defend their views on the connection between art and tourism, reduce from the amount of information related to culture and distinguish it for the needs of application in tourism (Touring guide interpretation, brochure, product of cultural tourism, as part of the tourist product, etc.)

## Skills, the student is able to:

- apply elements of culture for the needs of tourism (promotional material, compilation of a specific product, in the presentation of the tourist destination),
- assess the appropriateness and state the reason for linking cultural and tourism issues to other subjects,
- attends a short excursion,
- identify selected styles and describe their elements in practical exercises in the field.
