Final assessment:

During the semester the student prepares, presents at the seminar and submits a seminar work - preparation for the lesson. During the test period, student will take a knowledge test and verbal exam. To obtain an A (excellent) rating, you must earn at least 92%, evaluation B at 84%, evaluation C at least 76%, D at 65%, E at least 51%. A student who earns less than 51% will be ranked FX. The resulting evaluation is calculated as the average of the evaluation of the seminar paper, the knowledge test and the verbal answer.
