A student who has demonstrated less than 51% of required knowledges will be assessed degree of FX. Access to the final exam is conditional upon the successful presentation of the seminar papers.				
Course objective: Learning outcomes: The student is able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - define and by his own words interpret basic concepts of exegesis of the New Testament and the relations between them; - apply the historical and critical method of exegesis of the Bible in relation to books of Gospels, giving priority to objectiv and deep understanding of the literal and historical significance and meaning of the biblical texts; - apply the analytical method of exegesis of the Bible in relation to books of Gospels in order to properly understand and define the ethical and moral meaning of biblical texts; - apply the method of allegorical exegesis of Holy Scripture in relation to books of Gospels in order to properly understand and define the deep spiritual and mystical significance and meaning of the biblical texts; - apply auxiliaries sciences in exegesis of the biblical text; - applied technical devices for research of old manuscripts; - realize scientific analysis and textual critique of biblical texts; - apply methods of scientific analysis and critique of the biblical text in order to create a new translations and reviews of the biblical text as an essential prerequisite for a true and fair exegesis; - study old biblical manuscripts and editions of the Gospels, define their fair value, authenticity, integrity and authority for biblical research; - present the results of his biblical studies and research, discuss and justify his effectiveness in achieving of intended objectives; - define actual and practical bases from exegesis of the Gospels for the needs of the Church and society today.

The saturation of 5000 and 4000 people. A discussion about the Bread of Life. Peter's confession. The transfiguration. About the forgiveness of sins. The divorce.
