The subject is finished by the exam. During the semester the student processes and submits the seminar work. At the same time during the semester will absolve written test. During the exam period student will take a verbal exam. To obtain an A (excellent) rating, student must earn at least 95%, evaluation B at least 90%, rating C at least 80%, rating D 75%, rating E at least 70%. A student who earns less than 65% will be rated by FX. The final grade is calculated as the average of the evaluation of the seminar paper and the verbal answer.

Course objective:

- to interpret and describe in his own words the views of the patrologers on the return to the Holy Fathers literature;
- characterize the history of patrology;
- to professionally separate and describe the different periods of patrology by individual patrologers;
- to characterize works of the apostolic men and to describe individual writings from the viewing period of writings;
- to define the time of apostolic men by means of the characteristics of the socio-political and cultural situation of the time;
- to describe of individual representatives of apostolic men and the historical-critical and theological analysis of their work;
- historically, critically and theologically analyse of the writings of Apostolic men.
