Continuous assessment: tests in 6th and 11th week	Final assessment: During the semester the student passes the continuous compounding by tests in the 6th and 11th weeks of the study. To obtain an A (excellent) rating, he must receive at least 92%, score B at 84%, score C at least 76%, D at 65%, E at least 51%. A student who receives less than 51% will be ranked FX. The resulting rating is calculated as the average of the tests.			
Course objective: The graduate is able: - to interpret in his own words the origins of Old Slavic literature, to characterize the Old Slavonic and Church Slavonic language and the relationship between them; - to describe the spelling specificities of the Church Slavonic and apply them for text transcription and transnumerization; - to characterize the Church Slavonic phonetic and to justify the palatalized forms in the Church Slavonic text; - to present continuous reading of the Church text; - to classify and describe the declension of the Church Slavonic nouns as well as to explain the examples.
