**Final assessment:**

During the semester the student passes the continuous compounding by tests in the 6th and 11th weeks of the study. To obtain an A (excellent) rating, he must receive at least 92%, score B at 84%, score C at least 76%, D at 65%, E at least 51%. A student who receives less than 51% will be ranked FX. The resulting rating is calculated as the average of the tests.

- Present continuous reading of the Church text and apply morphological knowledge in the analysis and translation of texts.
