To Jesus in Jerusalem at the Feast of Tabernacles, to Jesus and the sinful woman, Christ's speech in the Jewish temple, healing of the blind man from birth, Good Shepherd, the murdered Galileans and repentance, Parable of the fig tree, healing of hunched women on Saturday, the doctrine about the kingdom of God in parables, Christ's speech in Solomon Hall, learning about the back way, prediction of the suffering of Jesus, parable about the dinner, true followers of Christ, the parable of the sheep, drachma and the prodigal son, parable of the unjust administrator, the parable about the rich and Lazarus, various warnings, coming kingdom of God, the parable of the Pharisee and a publican, about a divorce, blessing children, answer to the rich young man, laborers in the vineyard, the resurrection of Lazarus, the decision to sacrifice Jesus, pleading of the sons of Zebedee, the conversion of Zacchaeus, the parable of the pound, to Jesus in Bethany, Christ's entrance into Jerusalem, the cleansing of the temple, the question of power, the parable of the poor growers and the Royal wedding, the resurrection, Jesus talking to the Pharisees, the mysterious dinner and washing the apostles feet.
