The subject is completed by an exam. During a semester, student is supposed to write, present and submit a seminar paper. During an exam period, student undergoes an examination. To obtain an evaluation A (excellent) student must get at least 95%, to obtain an evaluation B student must get at least 90%, for C at least 80%, for D at least 75%, for E at least 70%. A student who obtains less than 60% will be evaluated by FX. A final evaluation will be calculated as the average of a seminar paper and written exam.
