The subject is finished by an exam. During the semester, the student actively participates in the seminar and at the end of the semester submits seminar work. During the examination period, he/she carries out an oral examination. The resulting evaluation is calculated as the average of the evaluation of the seminar work and the oral answer.

Course objective:

The student is able to:

- to bring the holy liturgy, its naming, provision, substance, character, role and meaning closer
- divide the liturgy methodically and analyze its parts,
- to bring to light and explain the purpose of the priest's preparation for the holy liturgy and to break down the prayers associated with it,
- characterize the proskomidium as a gift preparation, its naming, the origin and development of the ceremonial and textual pages,
- carry out a proskomidium with its sacrificial elements, prayers, recollection and consequently the covering of gifts and finishing (practical prayer and release abandonment).
- to characterize the liturgy of the catechumens with its name, origin, historical development, character and task,
- to bring the beginning and the initial prayers of the liturgy of the catechumens closer
- to analyze the structural parts of this liturgy greatness, silent prayer, antiphons, little prayer prayer, praise "One-Son Son ..."
- characterize a small entrance with its individuality, prayer and rites,
- to clarify the content of the Triennial Song Prayer and the Trinity Song itself,
- to highlight the meaning of reading the Holy Scripture on the liturgy, t. j. reading from the Apostle and the Gospel, after their content, text and ceremony,
- to characterize the temple discipline as the secret of the word, as a testimony of Christ in the Holy Spirit,
- bring the last part of the liturgy of the catechumen ectenie: to the suhubu, to the deceased and to the catechumens,
- to present a significant sacred act at the end of this part of the liturgy the development of antimins, its origin, its development and its present form.

Course content:

Naming, establishing, substance, character, role and meaning of the Holy Liturgy. Liturgy as the secret of the New Testament. Division of liturgy. Preparing a priest to perform the Holy Liturgy. His mental and physical disposition. Entrance Prayers. Dressing up in a priest's robe with appropriate prayers. Washing hands.

Proskomídia. Origin, evolution and symbolism. Preparation and Sacrifice of the Eucharistic Lamb. Prayers and Reminiscences on Proskomidia. Remembering the saints, the living and the deceased. Covering honorable gifts, prayer of benefit, completion of proskomidia.

Liturgy of Catechumens - Naming, Origin, Development, Character and Role. The Beginning of the Liturgy, the Ceremony of Cursing, the Initial Prayer, the Dialogue, the Holy Trinity Doxology with the Annunciation of the Kingdom of God.

Peaceful reverence, origin, history, interpretation and individuality. Antiphons, origin, history and meaning. Small ektenie and quiet prayers. Types of antiphons. Praise "Unborn Son ..."

Small entrance, origin, history, prayer, symbolism. Prayer of the Trinity. The Three-Hundred Fall.

Reading the Holy Scripture on the Liturgy - History, Development, Prayer Summons. Prokimen and reading the Apostle, song Alleluia and Reading the Gospel. Temple discipline. Ending the liturgy of catechumens. Ektenie - suhubā, for the deceased and for the catechumens. Opening antimins.
