After the course the student will be able:

- to formulate basic periods of philosophical thinking in Slovakia and the Czech Republic
- to characterize the most significant persons of Slovak and Czech philosophy
- to present their abilities of a creative interpretation of the primary philosophical literature
- characterize receptions of European philosophy in Slovakia and the Czech Republic

Course content:

Beginnings of religious-philosophical thinking in literary works of art from the period of Great Moravia. Philosophical Thinking in Slovakia and Czech Republic during Reformation and Anti-Reformation. "Prešov School" and "University of Trnava" in 17th and 18th Century. Enlightenment Philosophy in Slovakia and Czech Republic. Reception of Herder's and Kant's Philosophy in Slovakia. Slovak and Czech Hegelianism and anti-hegelianism. Reception of Nietzsche's philosophy in Slovakia and the Czech Republic. Positivism and Religion Philosophy in Slovakia and the Czech Republic. Ján Patočka's Philosophy.
