Final assessment:

During the semester the student passes the continuous compounding by tests in the 6th and 11th weeks of the study. To obtain an A (excellent) rating, he must receive at least 92%, score B at 84%, score C at least 76%, D at 65%, E at least 51%. A student who receives less than 51% will be ranked FX. The resulting rating is calculated as the average of the tests.

Course objective:

Graduate is able:

- to describe the daily cycle of divine services and the need for proper implementation;
- to characterize variable and unchangeable parts of divine services, to describe the basic system of their mutual combining;
- to define and describe in his own words the weekly and annual cycle of divine services;
- to classify the Church feasts and to describe the differences in their worships;
- to introduce and characterize basic divine services of the daily cycle, describe their origin, development and current practice;
- describe and classify types of worship hymns and give examples;
- to appoint the most important authors of the liturgical hymns and to present their contribution to the hymnography of the Orthodox Church.
