Course objective:

The graduate is able to:

- define and to interpret basic terms in the field of biblical studies with a focus on the Old Testament theology;
- interpret the teachings of the Orthodox Church about the Holy Scripture in general and every book of the Old Testament separately;
- formulate basic definitions of the canon of the Bible and the inspiration of the Holy Scripture;
- present isagogic information on individual books of the Bible - authorship, historical background, etc.;
- characterize and describe the life and contribution of the most important personalities of the Old Testament;
- describe the history of the creation of individual biblical writings and their incorporation into the canon of Bible books;
- explain and justify the necessity of producing ancient Bible translations and present their history and importance;
- explain and introduce Old Testament examples of a correct understanding of the meaning of life in the context of biblical learning;
- present basic information about the history of the Old Testament and its most prominent persons and events.
