To obtain an rating A, he must obtain at least 92%, to obtain an evaluation B he must obtain at least 84%, to obtain an evaluation C he must obtain at least 76%, to obtain an evaluation D he must obtain at least 65%, to obtain an evaluation E he must obtain at least 51%. A student who obtains less than 51% will be graded FX. Admission to the final exam is conditional on successful completion of the seminar assignment.

Course objective:

The graduate of the course can:

- define and interpret in their own words the basic concepts of social counseling and the relationships between them;
- describe the procedure of social counseling activities;
- recognize individual forms of social counseling;
- apply basic techniques of social counseling with spiritual and religious overlap.

Course content:

Course contents:

- Terminology and subject of social counseling: concept, theoretical definition, practical definition - legislative framework of application in social practice.
- Paradigms in social counseling, humanistic approach in social counseling.
- Tasks of social counseling. Counseling and mental maturity of social clients.
- Biodromal conception of human development and development and social counseling. An adult at the center of this counseling, transits, events, development tasks and social counseling.
- Social counseling aimed at target groups to whom social assistance and social services are addressed by law and at other target groups.
- Social counseling as a social service and professionalization of this service.
- Preparation and methods of implementing a social counseling event.
- Specifics of professional activity within the counseling relationship: social counselor - social clients (individual, group, community).
- Evaluation of social counseling as a social service.
