Conditions for passing the course:

During the semester, the student processes, presents at the seminar and submits a seminar paper - preparation for the lesson. During the exam period, he performs a knowledge test and an oral exam. To get an A rating (excellent) he must get at least 92%, to get a B rating 84%, to a C rating at least 76%, to a D rating 65%, to an E rating at least 51%. A student who obtains less than 51% will be graded FX. The final evaluation is calculated as the average of the evaluation of the seminar work, knowledge test and oral answer.

The graduate of the course can:

- define and interpret in their own words the basic concepts of the subject area;
- apply knowledge of different methods of working with risk groups in the majority society;
- define the starting points and needs for the prophylaxis of social services in society;
- evaluate the need for crisis intervention, select the most appropriate and effective variant of assistance to the excluded client.

Course content:

Basic terminology. Social pathology in social work. Social pathology and deviation. Method and techniques of social work. Addictions. Crime. Long-term unemployed. Domestic violence. Prostitution and human trafficking. Sects and new religions and their potential pathology in relation to family and society. Sports rioters. Fan projects. Suicide proceedings. Poverty and homelessness, etc.
