**Course objective:****Learning outcomes:**

After completing the course, the student will be able to:

- name and characterize the basic methodical and methodological approach to the study of dialects as non-written formations of the language.
- Explain the relationship of the written language as a codified formation and dialect as an uncodified national language formation.
- Apply acquired theoretical knowledge to the analysis of Rusyn and Slovak dialect text.
- Handles methods of dialectical research and the basics of phonetic transcription in the recording and transcription of narrative texts.
- Abstract from the interpreted narrative text of the common and distinct features of the normative Rusyn and the Rusyn dialects.
- Define the basic differences of the two main areas of the Rusyn dialect: Western and Eastern.
- Justify from the technical point of view the importance of dialect in studying the history of language (especially when determining the relative chronology of the phenomenon).
- To manage the division of Rusyn dialects in the context of the Carpathorusyn Carpathian language areal and their basic differentiation signs.
- Based on the acquired knowledge, to work with specialized literature (with primary and secondary sources), to search for information in information databases.

10. The division of East Slovak dialects from the aspect of Slovak-Ruthenian-Polish language contacts.
