<b>Course objective:</b> The student is able to: - define and interpret in own words basic family social work terminology and terminology of specialized family social counselling, - processed a report on the family living situation and its members with respect to the strengths and weaknesses of the family system functioning, - application of his/her competencies, skills and abilities to make the plan of the helping process of family at risk, - assess the living situation of the family and its members with the help of Assessment Model of B. Balogová, - apply general theories and concepts of the family in social work practice, - describe the process of working with the family, the different phases and principles of work with the family, - specify, characterize basic but also specific methods and techniques used in work with families with a focus on strengthening the family system, - discuss the Slovak family policy system, system of social services for families and children.		
<b>Course content:</b> Basic terminology of the family as the client's social work (signs and characteristics of current family). General theory of family, selected social and therapeutic approaches. The problem of objectivity and standards in assessing the living conditions of families. Model of family living situation assessment by B. Balogová. The process of working with the family - a system approach to social work with families. Selected approaches, methods and techniques of working with the family – family preservation (case conferences), family counseling, sociotherapy with family, social and legal protection of the family. The family in the context of social policy - family policy, family social services, family and parent centers. Specifics of selected types of clinical families (family immature, incomplete family, family members with troubled family in divorce situation, multiproblem family).
