During the semester student will prepare one seminary work, which will be presented and will be given on seminar. Student will be prepare to studying.









During the semester student will do knowledge test.

Course objective:

The student of this course is able to:

-  define and explicate basic determinants of social work and the relationship between them;
-  explain consequences and importance of modernizing the social work, justify it's impact to client;
-  define concepts of social functioning and living situations of the client;
-  describe the process of assessment and theory of social work, which was chosen of social worker in his work with client;
-  characterize and know, how to apply and classify the theories of social work, know their variability and potential application in relation to the client;
-  define and describe basic methods of social work at the mikro, meso and makro levels;
-  able to analyze different conceptions of social work in the context of social work as social construction and social change, their specific and consequences in relation to client;
-  define postmodernism and it's implications for social work.

Course content:

Social determinants of social work - consequences of modernization for social work, the future of social work; concepts of social functioning and life situations.

Assessment and choice theory - research on application of theory of social work in practice, eclecticism.

Theory of social work - humanistic and existential theories, social-psychology and communication theories, systemic theory, cognitive-behavioral theory, task-centred approach, anti-oppressive approaches, sociobiology, socio-ekological model and tradition of phenomenology.

Methods and procedures of social work - Case work: case work, counseling, crisis intervention, mediation; Working with group and families: group work, streetwork, work with the family, assessment of needs of vulnerable children, videotraining of interactions, Community work: community work, mass disaster and coping with them.

Macromethods and management of social work - to analyze the social needs of the regions, village and the region, system projects, management in social work, supervision.

Different understanding of social work - SW as a social construction, SW as a social change, SW as part of a highly institutionalized society, postmodernism in SW.
