During the semester, students actively participate in seminars and implements a continuous test. They perform the exam during the exam period.

## **Final assessment:**

Course title: German Phonetics and Phonology

The course is completed by an exam. To obtain an A rating (excellent) they must obtain at least 90%, to obtain a B rating 80%, to a C rating at least 70%, to a D rating 60%, to an E rating at least 50%. A student who obtains less than 50% will be graded FX. The final evaluation is calculated as the average of the evaluation of work in seminars and exams.

#### **Course objective:**

The graduate of the course is:

- aware of the peculiarities of the German vocal and consonant system in comparison with Slovak,

- aware of the peculiarities of segmental and suprasegmental properties of German in comparison with Slovak.

## **Course content:**

- The subject of phonetics and phonology, tasks and goals of the discipline, the place of phonetics and phonology within linguistics.

- Phoneme and graphema, development of graphematic system.
- Segmental and suprasegmental phonetics and phonology. Phonotactics, syllable (onset, nucleus, code) onset structures,
- structures in code, syllable and morpheme, distribution of vowels in German, positional realizations of vowels.
- Phono-stylistic levels, phono-stylistic levels in German, phonetic properties of individual phono-stylistic levels. - Coarticulation - assimilation, reduction, elimination, apocop.
- Intonation (inventory and meaning of suprasegmental language components, relevant prosodic properties).
- Codification of pronunciation, history and issues.
- Classification of the system of vocals, diphthongs and consonants (contrastive comparison of German and Slovak).
