<b>Continuous assessment:</b> During the semester, the student takes a written test as part of the continuous assessment.	<b>Final assessment:</b> During the examination period, students take a written examination in the theory and practical part of the course. The practical part of the course consists in the elaboration of lexicological tasks from scripts. To obtain an A rating (excellent), students must obtain at least 90%, to obtain a B rating 80%, to a C rating at least 70%, to a D rating 60%, to an E rating at least 50%. A student who obtains less than 50% will be graded FX. The final evaluation is calculated as the average of the continuous evaluation and the final evaluation of the work as well as the student's work during the whole semester.	
<b>Course objective:</b> The graduate of the course can: - identify word boundaries, morphemes, lexemes, phrases, - determine the lexical, grammatical and word-formation meaning of words, - identify similarities and differences in the vocabulary of Germany, Austria, Switzerland, - identify word-formation procedures of German lexemes and compare them with procedures in the Slovak language.		
<b>Course content:</b> Lexicology as a linguistic discipline, vocabulary as a part of the language system, word, morpheme, lexeme, delimitation and definition, lexical, grammatical and word formation, semantic concepts, motivation, types of motivation, remotivation, vocabulary of the German language in Germany, Austria, Switzerland, syntagmatic and paradigmatic relations, onomasiology, semasiology, etymology, phraseology, stylistics, lexicography, borrowed words, borrowings, anglicisms, onomastics, social division of vocabulary, German-language word formation, word-formation procedures, word-formative nouns
