Continuous assessment: During the semester, the student takes a written knowledge test as part of the continuous assessment.	Final assessment: During the exam period a student writes a test from theory and practice of the course. Practical part of the course comprises the elaboration of the textual-linguistic tasks. A student needs at least 90% for evaluation A, at least 80% for evaluation B, at least 70% for evaluation C, at least 60% for evaluation D and at least 50% for evaluation E. A student reaching less than 50% receives an FX. The final evaluation is calculated as the average evaluation of the continual assessment and final assessment of the work of a student during the whole term.	
Course objective: The graduate of the course can: - define the text on the basis of certain criteria, - determine the characteristics of the text according to the type of text, - specify criteria for textuality, - analyze coherence and cohesion, - analyze typical spoken and written expression in German, - determine the conventions of text classes.		
Course content: Textual linguistics as a linguistic discipline, textual and sentence linguistics, stylistics, similarities and differences between textual linguistics and stylistics, pragmatic turn, model of textual production and reception, criteria of textuality, isotropy, grammatical conditions of textual coherence, textual functions, textual type and textual class, characteristics of text types: journalistic, economic, political, scientific text, spoken and written expression, cohesion.
