ADMISSION PROCEEDINGS

Applicants will be admitted without an entrance exam if the number of registered applicants does not exceed the planned number by more than 25%. If the number of applicants is higher, the entrance exam will be held. after the completion of the admission proceedings, i.e. after the meeting of the admission committee. A written decision on the result of the admission proceedings will be delivered to the applicant in person within the statutory deadline.
