Conditions for passing the course: Form of assessment: Final evaluation: <i>The course is completed with an interim assessment. During the semester the student carries out clinical practice in professional laboratories, at the Department of Dental Hygiene and selected departments of the University Hospital, contractual medical institutions, pre-school institutions and primary schools. During the examination period, the student conducts a knowledge test, an oral and a practical examination, all of which are recorded in the Student's Clinical Practicum Logbook.</i> <i>Pass criteria: must obtain at least 90.00% for an A grade, 89.99 - 80.00% for a B grade, 79.99 - 70.00% for a C grade, 69.99 - 60.00% for a D grade, 59.99 - 50.00% for an E grade. A student scoring 49.99% or less will be given a grade of FX.</i> <i>The final grade will be calculated as the average of the semester activity grade, the knowledge test, and the practical skills assessment.</i> <i>The student's total course load is 130 hours</i>	
Learning outcomes : <i>Upon completion of the course, students will be able to:</i> Knowledge: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>define and interpret in their own words the basic concepts of periodontology and cariology;</i> - <i>clinically examine and differentiate between healthy and pathologically altered gingiva, mucogingival area and changes in hard dental tissues;</i> - <i>be able to properly motivate, instruct and treat patients based on the examination;</i> - <i>describe the procedure for the examination and differential diagnosis of diseases of the gingiva and mucogingival region,</i> - <i>theoretically describe the various options for tooth whitening and determine the correct indications and contraindications for tooth whitening.</i> Skills: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>examine all possible changes of the teeth, gingiva, periodontium and mucogingival area and, on this basis, correctly motivate, instruct and treat the patient;</i> - <i>investigate and make a differential diagnosis of dental, gingival, periodontal and mucogingival disorders;</i> - <i>perform complete supragingival periodontal treatment with periodontal instruments;</i> - <i>perform a complete supragingival treatment of the periodontium by ultrasound;</i> - <i>chemically treat the supragingival area;</i> - <i>chemically treat the supragingival area;</i> Competencies: <i>Use knowledge and skills for professional and personal development especially in the form of:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>respecting the delegation of tasks in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases in the mucogingival area; About the cooperation of the dental hygienist and the dentist in changes in the gingiva and the</i>

Course content:

Motivation and instruction of patients with severe periodontal damage. Treatment of hospitalized patients in specialized units using the dental hygiene process method: assessment (history and physical assessment), nursing diagnosis, planning, implementation and evaluation of the treatment process. Education of clients in relation to their dental problem. Developing an educational program for a specific client
