<p><b>Prerequisites for completion of the course:</b> continuous assessment</p> <p>A: Pass:  60 hours in the gynaecology department  90 hours in the obstetrics department  90 hours in the labour ward  30 hours in the neonatal unit  1 written test with a maximum score of 80 points / success rate min 70%</p> <p>B: Pass:  1 nursing care plan for a woman with a selected gynaecological problem - max 5 points  1 nursing care plan for a six-week-old woman - max 5 points  1 nursing care plan for a physiological newborn - max 5 points</p> <p>C: perform and record the required procedures in each department:  - counselling and antenatal examinations for 25 pregnant women  (at the end of the course: 100 antenatal examinations in pregnant women)  - supervision and care of 25 physiological newborns  (at the end of the study: 100 newborn care)  - supervision and care of 25 sextuplets  (at the end of the study: 100 postnatal examinations of sextuplets)  - 1 supervised physiological birth delivered independently  (at the end of the study: 30 supervised physiological deliveries)  - supervision and care of 10 parturients at different stages of labour  (at the end of the study: 40 mothers in each stage of labour)  - 5 assisted physiological births  (at the end of the study: 20 assisted physiological births)</p> <p>Recording of the prescribed performances is done by the student in the Clinical Practice Record II according to the criteria of the Ministry of Health of the Slovak Republic from 22.1.2013. 50% of the performances must be performed in the Prešov University Hospital.</p> <p>Credits will be awarded based on the fulfilment of all the requirements as per the grading scale A, B, C, D, E, FX - Study Regulations of PU in Prešov</p> <p><b>Note:</b>  To complete the course, 90% student participation in KLCPA1 is mandatory.
