PLACEMENT	INFORMATION
Department / Function	English, Spanish, German or French language classroom assistants in Infant, Primary and Secondary education at a private school that follows the International Baccalaureate programme.
Description of activities	This placement is suited to students considering a career in Education and would like experience assisting in a private school that caters for infants, primary and secondary education.
	There are opportunities for students to assist in English, French, German, Science, Geography, History, Physical Education, Drama, Music, Art and Maths classes. There is also the opportunity to gain experience in sports coaching for interschool tournaments, debating clubs, school musical production, supervision at break times and other extra-curricular activities.
	Our pupils are aged from 3 – 18 years. You would be partnered according to your preference with an Infant, Primary or Secondary teacher.
	The minimum level of competence expected from the language assistant is C2 (CEFR) in all four skills.
	You would work alongside and support our bilingual teachers by helping with the planning and developing of activities and making/adapting resources according to children's abilities and learning styles.
	You would also take small conversation groups to allow our pupils to carry out skills-based activities and encourage communication in the target language. Through questioning, instructions, modelling, conversation and role plays you will be able to help our pupils practice reading, pronunciation, dictation, comprehension and speaking in authentic contexts, enabling them to improve their language skills and to better access our International Baccalaureate curriculum. You would support differentiation either on a one-to-one basis or through group work and provide extra support to pupils whose mother tongue is not Spanish, if required.
	Intercultural strategies are used to promote a positive learning environment and encourage the pupil's international mindedness and you would be expected to demonstrate an understanding, patient, warm, and receptive attitude towards the pupils and show interest in their progress.
	You would help out a maximum of 25 hours per week from Monday to Friday and one Saturday Open morning per term. It is preferred but not essential that you speak Spanish, however there is plenty of opportunity to practise your Spanish with our staff and you will also be provided with Spanish classes and language exchanges whilst you are here.
