	of Public Education) and coordinated by the British Council, so pupils study Science and Geography in English from the age of 6 to 11 for 6 or 7 hours per week.  At the moment 354 students attend BEI classes, but next school year the percentage will rise up to 65% of the enrolled students of the Primary School.  In the 2014/2015 school year 20 classes out of 31 will been involved in the Bilingual Project.
