Criteria for evaluating the fulfilment of conditions for obtaining scientific-pedagogical titles or artistic-pedagogical titles of Associate Professor and Professor

In accordance with Section 12(1)(c) of Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Certain Acts (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), in accordance with Decree of the Ministry of Education of the Slovak Republic No. 246/2019 Coll. on the procedure for obtaining scientific-pedagogical titles or artistic-pedagogical titles of Associate Professor and Professor (hereinafter referred to as the "Decree"), in accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Scientific Council of the University of Prešov, after prior discussion in the scientific councils of the faculties of the University of Prešov in Prešov, the Scientific Council of the University of Prešov approved at its meeting on 31 December 2025 the following criteria for assessing the fulfilment of the conditions for obtaining the scientific-pedagogical title of "Associate Professor" (hereinafter referred to as "criteria for obtaining the title of Associate Professor") and criteria for evaluating the fulfilment of the conditions for obtaining the scientific-pedagogical title of "Professor" (hereinafter referred to as "criteria for obtaining the title of Professor").

Article 1 Criteria for obtaining the title of Associate Professor

1. The applicant meets the basic qualification requirements and has completed a third-level university education.
2. The applicant has been working in a scientific and pedagogical or artistic and pedagogical capacity in the given field of study or a related field at a university for at least three years since obtaining a third-level university degree in which he or she is to be awarded the title of Associate Professor. This work mainly includes giving lectures on selected topics, supervising final theses, leading seminars and exercises, or other similar forms of teaching. Only the period during which the applicant was employed by a university, at least for a shorter working time of at least half of the established weekly working time (including abroad), is taken into account for the performance of teaching activities.
3. The applicant shall demonstrate that their scientific work has resulted in a comprehensive scientific work in the given field of study or that their artistic works and performances have resulted in a comprehensive artistic work in the given field of study. The applicant shall also demonstrate that they are a recognised scientific figure in professional circles or a recognised artistic figure in artistic circles at home and abroad in the given field of study. The applicant shall demonstrate these facts by fulfilling at least the specific criteria in the relevant field of study in which he or she is applying for the title of Associate Professor. The specific requirements for fulfilling these criteria for individual research areas, fields of study and university departments are set out in Annexes 1 to 8.

Article 2 Criteria for obtaining the title of Professor

1. The applicant meets the basic qualification requirements and holds the title of Associate Professor obtained on the basis of the preparation and defence of a habilitation thesis and successful completion of the habilitation procedure.
2. The candidate has been scientifically and pedagogically or artistically and pedagogically active in the given field of study or related field of study at a university for at least three years since obtaining the title of Associate Professor in subjects from the field in which he or she is to be awarded the title of Professor. For the performance of pedagogical activities, only the period during which the candidate was employed by the university, at least for a shorter working time of at least half of the established weekly working time (including abroad), gave lectures, seminars and exercises and supervised doctoral students, shall be taken into account.
3. The applicant shall demonstrate the publication of at least one university textbook or two lecture notes or teaching texts.
4. The applicant shall demonstrate successful training of at least two doctoral students in the given or related field of study and training of at least one doctoral student in the given or related field of study.
5. The applicant shall demonstrate that he or she is a recognised scientific or artistic figure in the given field of study and that his or her scientific work or artistic works have achieved wide international recognition. The applicant shall demonstrate this by meeting at least the specific criteria in the relevant field of study in which he or she is applying for the title of Professor. The specific requirements for meeting these criteria for individual research areas, fields of study and university departments are set out in Annexes 1 to 8. In addition, the applicant shall demonstrate international recognition by means of supporting written statements from at least three professors or other leading foreign experts from at least three countries, with at least two statements coming from experts from a country other than the Czech Republic.

Article 3 Common provisions

1. Applicants for the title of Associate Professor or Professor shall submit an application containing the requirements specified in the decree and in the UP Principles on the Procedure for Obtaining the Titles of Associate Professor and Professor, which are determined by a measure of the UP Rector.
2. In the habilitation procedure, the fulfilment of the criteria and other conditions shall be reviewed by the habilitation committee. It shall state its conclusion on the fulfilment or non-fulfilment of the criteria in a written proposal, which it shall submit to the chair of the faculty's Scientific Council.
3. In the inauguration procedure, the appointment committee reviews the fulfilment of the criteria and other conditions. It shall state its conclusion on the fulfilment or non-fulfilment of the criteria in a written proposal, which it shall submit to the chair of the faculty's scientific council.
4. When proving citations, self-citations and semi-self-citations are excluded.
5. In the case of applicants from abroad, works published and citations published in works in the applicant's country of origin are considered domestic publications and domestic citations. Experts from abroad are not considered experts from their

country of origin.

6. Fulfilment of the above minimum criteria cannot be replaced by fulfilment of other criteria.
7. Fulfilment of these criteria does not constitute grounds for successful completion of the habilitation procedure and inauguration procedure for the position of Professor.

Article 4 Transitional and final provisions

1. The criteria for evaluating the fulfilment of the conditions for obtaining scientific-pedagogical titles or artistic-pedagogical titles of Associate Professor and Professor at the University of Prešov shall become effective upon approval by the Scientific Council of the University of Prešov on 31 December 2025.
2. Proceedings for the award of the titles of Associate Professor and Professor that began before these criteria came into effect shall be completed in accordance with the existing regulations and criteria.
3. The Criteria for the evaluation of the fulfilment of conditions for obtaining scientific-pedagogical titles or artistic-pedagogical titles of Associate Professor and Professor at the University of Prešov of 31 March 2025 are hereby repealed.
