# Learning outcomes:

#### Knowledge:

The student has knowledge of sources of information (textbooks, studies, monographic works). Student is familiar with the most important stages of older Ukrainian literature, the rich translations of the Kievan Rus period, as well as original works and their authors, their best works. He/she has information about the historical background of some artistic phenomena.

#### Skills

The student is able to analyze the semantic and formal features of texts of older Ukrainian literature, determine their genre and style features. Can analyze works by typical methods, define their meaning in a given epoch.

# **Competencies**

The graduate understands the context and reasons for the formation of certain genres (chronicle, poem, sermon, fable) and thematic and functional areas (preachers' literature, hagiographic, historiographic, etc.) of literature. Student is able to use the acquired knowledge in his professional life.

# Course content:

- 1. Periodization of older Ukrainian literature. 1.Definition of the term, its peculiarities, the current state of research.
- 2. Literature of the Kievan Rus period (11th 13th century);
- 3. Ukrainian literature of the 14th and first half of the 16th century.;
- 4. Ukrainian literature of the second half of the 16th and 17th centuries.;
- 5. Ukrainian poetry in the second half of the 16th and 17th centuries.;
- 6. Dramatic works in the 17th century.;
- 7. Historical prose in the 17th century.;
- 8. Ukrainian literature in the 18th century. (Cossack letopises, dramatic works, sociopolitical satire);
- 9. H. S. Skovoroda (philosophy, pedagogy, poetry, fables, poems, parables).
