# Knowledge:

The student acquires precedent texts of Ukrainian literature in the Ukrainian language. Through this method, student acquires knowledge about facts, events, phenomena and personalities that form the model of Ukrainian culture. The student knows about the specifics of the formation of new Ukrainian literature, has knowledge of the socio-political circumstances that influenced this process.

#### Skills:

The aim of the course is to acquire the ability and skills, to understand, analyze and interpret a text in the Ukrainian language. Works of classical Ukrainian literature will serve as a material basis for this level of study.

## **Competencies**

The study contributes to the formation of the student's personality. We pursue this goal within the intentions of the basic thesis: language through culture, which is the content of foreign language education, and culture through language, which is part of culture. Through the form of dialogue of cultures in intercultural communication, we aim to deepen the student's intercultural competence.

#### Course content:

Commented reading of classic works of Ukrainian literature from the end of the 19th - beginning of the 20th century by authors such as: T. Shevchenko, P. Kulish, M. Vovchok, I. Franko, L. Ukrainka. Interpretation and analysis of texts.
