Knowledge:

The student acquires precedent texts of Ukrainian literature in the Ukrainian language. Through this method, student acquires knowledge about facts, events, phenomena and personalities that form the model of Ukrainian culture. The student knows about the specifics of the formation of new Ukrainian literature, has knowledge of the socio-political circumstances that influenced this process.

Skills:

The aim of the course is to acquire the ability and skills, to understand, analyze and interpret a text in the Ukrainian language. Works of contemporary Ukrainian literature written after 1991 will serve as a material basis at this level of study.

Competencies

The study contributes to the formation of the student's personality. We pursue this goal within the intentions of the basic thesis: language through culture, which is the content of foreign language education, and culture through language, which is part of culture. Through the form of dialogue of cultures in intercultural communication, we aim to deepen the student's intercultural competence.

Course content:

Works or their excerpts from Ukrainian authors after 1991: J. Andruchovyč, O. Zabužko, H. Pahutjak, S. Žadan, J. Kononenko, M. Matios, T. Prochasko. Thematically, this area will be further expanded and deepened. Interpretation of assigned works in the context of the most recent events. Reading periodicals, understanding Ukrainian radio and television programs, movies. Development of linguistic competence. Distinguishing between idioms, colloquial speech, slang. Observation of interference phenomena in language.
