#### Final evaluation:

The course is completed with an examination. During the semester, students are required to prepare a presentation on an assigned topic in the field of conservative dentistry (20% of the course grade) and fulfill the conditions of participation according to the Study Regulations of the FM PU. The course ends with an examination (80% of the course grade).

The success criteria (percentage of results in the course evaluation) for the classification levels are as follows: A: 100.00 - 90.00 %; B: 89.99 - 80.00 %; C: 79.99 - 70.00 %; D: 69.99 - 60.00 %; E: 59.99 - 50.00 %; FX: 49.99 and less % at least 50 %. A student scoring less than 50% will be graded with a grade of FX. Student Load:

- apply knowledge in the motivation and treatment of patients with oral diseases.

### Competencies:

- work and collaborate in a team and build their identity as a dental hygienist,
- articulate and implement knowledge in order to develop relationships with other members of the dental team in providing patient care,
- integrate general knowledge when communicating with the cariology patient.

### **Course content:**

Conservative dentistry, client examination, caries formation and progression, division of caries cavities, conservative treatment of caries, problems of aesthetics of fillings, abrasions, erosions of hard tooth tissues, sensitive tooth cavities, causes and treatment. Endodontics, pain as a symptom, differential diagnosis, inflammation of the pulp, causes, symptoms, treatment, methods of treatment of dental canals, granuloma and

inflammation of the dentition.
