Lemko small prose after deportation in Poland: an overview of the works of Seman Madzeľan, Nestor Repela, Ivan Želem and Teodor Kuziak.

The literary and cultural life of the Rusyns in the 1950s and 1980s. The horizon of the poetic and prose works of Angel Prokop, Michal Kovač, Mikola M. Kočiš, Ďura Papharhaj and others.

Theater life of Vojvodina and Rusyn National Theater «Дядя». The dramatic production of Ďura Papharhaj.

The Rusyn Literary Life in Subcarpathian and in Prešov Region. Literary and cultural life under conditions of forbidden Rusyn nationality, folklore and popular verbal creativity.

The third national revival of the Carpathian Rusyns in the inter-war period. Overview of poetic and prose works in Slovakia: Š. Suchý, J. Charitun, J. Kudzej, Š. Smolej, M. Maćcovská and others.
