Conditions for passing the course:	
Form of assessment: <i>exam</i> The course is completed by an oral exam. During the semester, the student actively participates in lectures and seminars, prepares a seminar paper on a selected topic and presents it (PP-presentation) in class. During the exam period, the student will demonstrate his knowledge during the oral exam. The final evaluation is calculated as the average of the evaluation of the seminar paper (25%), its PP-presentation (25%) and oral answer (50%). To obtain an A rating (excellent) he must obtain at least 90%, to obtain a B rating 80%, to obtain a C rating at least 70%, to obtain a D rating 60%, to obtain an E rating at least 50%. A student who obtains less than 50% will be graded FX.
