The doctoral programme prepares students for independent research, academic teaching, and scholarly engagement. The curriculum emphasizes three core areas:

- **Philosophy:** Focused on theoretical and practical branches (e.g., hermeneutics, phenomenology, political and social philosophy), with attention to historical, theoretical, and methodological depth.
- **Ethics:** Including environmental, global, professional ethics, and the history of ethical thought.
- **Aesthetics:** Covering musical, visual, and theatrical aesthetics, along with methodological approaches.

Graduates are equipped to conduct original research, contribute to international academic discourse, and critically engage with cultural and social issues. They are prepared to lead research projects, collaborate across disciplines, and communicate with both academic and public audiences with intellectual rigor and ethical responsibility.

Tuition fee: 3 000 EUR / per year

Requirements: English language competence at B2 and higher (CEFR level)
