- **The applicant shall submit a certified copy of the secondary school leaving certificate together with the application or send it to the faculty's address immediately upon its issuance, no later than the date of enrolment in the university study.**
- The applicant shall submit a curriculum vitae **signed** by the applicant.
- If an applicant wishes to apply for more than one study programme at the faculty, a separate application must be submitted for each individual study programme, and an application fee must be paid for each application. An applicant may not apply simultaneously for both full-time and part-time forms of study in the same study programme.
- An applicant with specific needs, pursuant to Art. 100 of the Act no.: 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education, as amended, shall document such specific needs in the application by submitting the relevant request and supporting certificate. The request form is published on the faculty's website in the section Uchádzači – možnosti štúdia.
- **Incomplete applications will not be accepted, and the admission proceedings fee is non-refundable.** *Note: Upon completion of the first-degree study programme (Bc.), it is possible to continue to the second-degree study (Mgr.) in all study programmes.*

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

A prerequisite for admission is the submission of an officially certified translation of the secondary school leaving certificate and a recognition certificate of the foreign education qualification (<https://uznanie.minedu.sk/category/uznavacia-dolozka>). All documents must be officially certified and submitted within the deadline to Referát pre vzdelávanie PF PU. Applicants are strongly advised to complete a preparatory course of the Slovak language. Self-financing applicants are admitted on contract basis. The regulations concerning tuition fee and other charges for the relevant academic year are published at <https://www.unipo.sk/pedagogicka-fakulta>. The provisions set out below, regarding the entrance procedure, are equally applicable to international applicants.

ADMISSION PROCEEDINGS

The admission examination will focus on assessing the applicant's personal motivation and academic aptitude for study in the teacher training programme (interview and general aptitude test). The ranking of applicants will be determined based on the scores obtained in the admission examination. The admission examination will take place on the premises of the Faculty of Education, University of Prešov. The date and time of the examination will be communicated to applicants via MAIS. Enrolment in university studies will take place on 2nd July 2026.

The results of the admission procedure will be published in the MAIS information system (https://mais.unipo.sk/eprihlaska/pages/odosielatel/rozhranie_odosielatela.mais) upon the completion of the admission proceedings, i.e., following the meeting of the Admissions Committee. A written decision on the outcome of the admission proceedings will be delivered to applicants within the statutory period.

Study programme: **SPECIAL EDUCATION**

Qualification level of study: **Bc.**

Form of study: **full-time (DSPB), part-time (ESPB3)**

Graduates may be employed as:

- teaching professionals – teachers in kindergartens for children with special education needs, teaching assistant, educators and masters of vocational education for special education work in special elementary schools, practical schools, vocational schools, special and specialised elementary school classrooms for individuals with health disabilities, children coming from socially disadvantaged environment, and for talented children.
