- successful completion of a bachelor-degree programme in Teacher Training and Education Science study field in the study programme of Preschool and Elementary Education, the study programme of Preschool and Elementary Education of Psycho-socially Disabled, or the study programme of Special Education,
- certificate of medical fitness for university studies **in the field of Teacher Training and Education Science for the profession of Teacher, and Special Education Teacher** (the form is available at the faculty's website in the section Uchádzcači – možnosti štúdia),
- delivery of a printed and signed application form that has been submitted also electronically.

- Application is to be submitted via university's Modular Academic Information System (MAIS) – Electronic application:

- Once completed, the application must be printed, signed, the required attachments enclosed, and sent to the Admissions Office of the Faculty of Education, University of Presov.
In the case of submitting the application electronically, a printed version of the application form must also be submitted.
- Confirmation of the weighted arithmetic mean values of grades achieved during bachelor-degree study must be delivered to the faculty address by **22nd May 2026**. This confirmation is required only from applicants who completed their bachelor-degree study at a different faculty.
- A certified copy of bachelor-degree diploma and the diploma supplements must be delivered to the faculty address by **13th July 2026**. These documents are required only from applicants who completed their bachelor-degree study at a different faculty.
- A personally signed curriculum vitae must be delivered by post or submitted in person.
- If an applicant wants to apply for more than one study programme at the faculty, a **separate** application must be submitted for each study programme, and the application fee must be paid for each application. An applicant may not apply for both full-time and part-time study in the same study programme.
- An applicant with specific needs, pursuant to Art. 100 of the Act no.: 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education as amended, must provide documentary evidence for such specific needs in the application by submitting the relevant request and supporting certificate. The request is published on the faculty's website in the section Uchádzači – možnosti štúdia.
- **Incomplete applications will not be accepted, and the admission proceedings fee is non-refundable.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

A requirement for admission is the submission of an officially certified translation of completion of the document confirming completion a bachelor-degree study programme and a certificate of recognition of the level of foreign education (<https://uznanie.minedu.sk/category/uznavacia-dolozka>). The documents must be officially certified and submitted within the prescribed deadline to the Referát pre vzdelávanie PF PU. Applicants are advised to complete a preparatory course in the Slovak language. Self-paying students are admitted on the basis of a contract. The directive on tuition fees and charges for the relevant academic year is published at <https://www.unipo.sk/pedagogicka-fakulta>. The information on the admissions procedure provided below is also applicable to international applicants.

ADMISSION PROCEEDINGS

Applicants are admitted without taking an entrance exam. If the number of applicants exceeds the administrative capacities planned by the faculty by 25%, the decisive criterion shall be the weighted grade point average achieved in the bachelor-degree study programme. The admission proceedings results will be published in the MAIS information system https://mais.unipo.sk/eprihlaska/pages/odosielatel/rozhranie_odosielatela.mais after the completion of the admission proceedings i.e. following the meeting of the admission committee. A written decision on the result of the admission proceedings will be delivered to applicants within the statutory time limit.
