Aim The main aim of the conference is to discuss findings of the research project entitled

"Slovak-Ukrainian cross-border cooperation amid and after COVID-19 pandemic: factors and perspectives, impact on policies" that has been implemented by the Institute of Political Sciences (IPOL - Faculty of Arts, University of Prešov) with the support of the Slovak Research and Development Agency (project no. APVV-21-0057). The project aimed at identifying impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic and Russia's invasion of Ukraine on the Slovak-Ukrainian Cross-Border Cooperation (SK-UA CBC). It looked for opportunities and limits for SK-UA CBC brought on by, first, changing institutional framework for relations between the EU with Ukraine, as well as governmental policies of Slovakia and its relations with Ukraine; second, factors of perceptions and preferences of regional and local cross-border cooperation actors amid and after the COVID-19 pandemic, as well as the recent war, influencing their

capacity to take an advantage of existing and presumed opportunities.
