The basic condition for admission

The **basic condition** for admission to doctoral studies is the completion of a **second-degree study programme (other conditions are specified in the framework requirements of individual study programmes)**. The applicant applies on the form **Application for doctoral studies** of the ŠEVT with the required attachments, which is sent to the Unit for Education and Doctoral Studies of the Faculty of Arts PU in Prešov. The statement of results of the master's studies is attached in the form of an addendum to the diploma (in this case it is not necessary to fill in the table Statement of results of the master's studies on page 2 of the application form).

Form of admission

The entrance examination is oral and includes a debate on a research issue related to the topic of the projected dissertation.

Applicants will take the entrance examination in their chosen field of study and in **one or two chosen world languages** (according to the requirements of the relevant study programme).

Applicants will take the entrance examination in their chosen field of study and in one or two chosen world languages (according to the requirements of the relevant programme of study).

Graduates of the university in the academic year 2025/2026, who will not have a diploma issued by the application deadline, will attach to the application a certificate of passing the state examination and defending the diploma thesis, issued by the study department of the relevant faculty, and will bring the diploma to the admission interview, or will deliver the diploma, the certificate of the state examination and the supplement to the diploma (officially certified) no later than June 30, 2026.

The Faculty will not accept applications received after the closing date or without the required elements.

Annexes to the application for doctoral studies

1. CV - signed by the applicant;
2. proof of payment of the admission fee - paste on the 3rd page of the application form;
3. officially certified photocopies of documents of graduation (university diploma, certificate of state examination, supplement to the diploma - statement of the results of master's studies; or certificate of passing the state examination and thesis defence); unofficially certified and unattested copies of documents of graduation from foreign universities will not be accepted;
4. a list of professional and scientific works published to date;
5. a framework project of the dissertation on the topic written by the supervisor (1-3 pages), including a compulsory annotation in English (5-10 lines);
6. on the first page of the application form (after the topic of the dissertation) it is also necessary to indicate the world language from which the applicant will take the entrance examination; abbreviations used: AJ (English), NJ (German), FJ (French), RJ (Russian).
